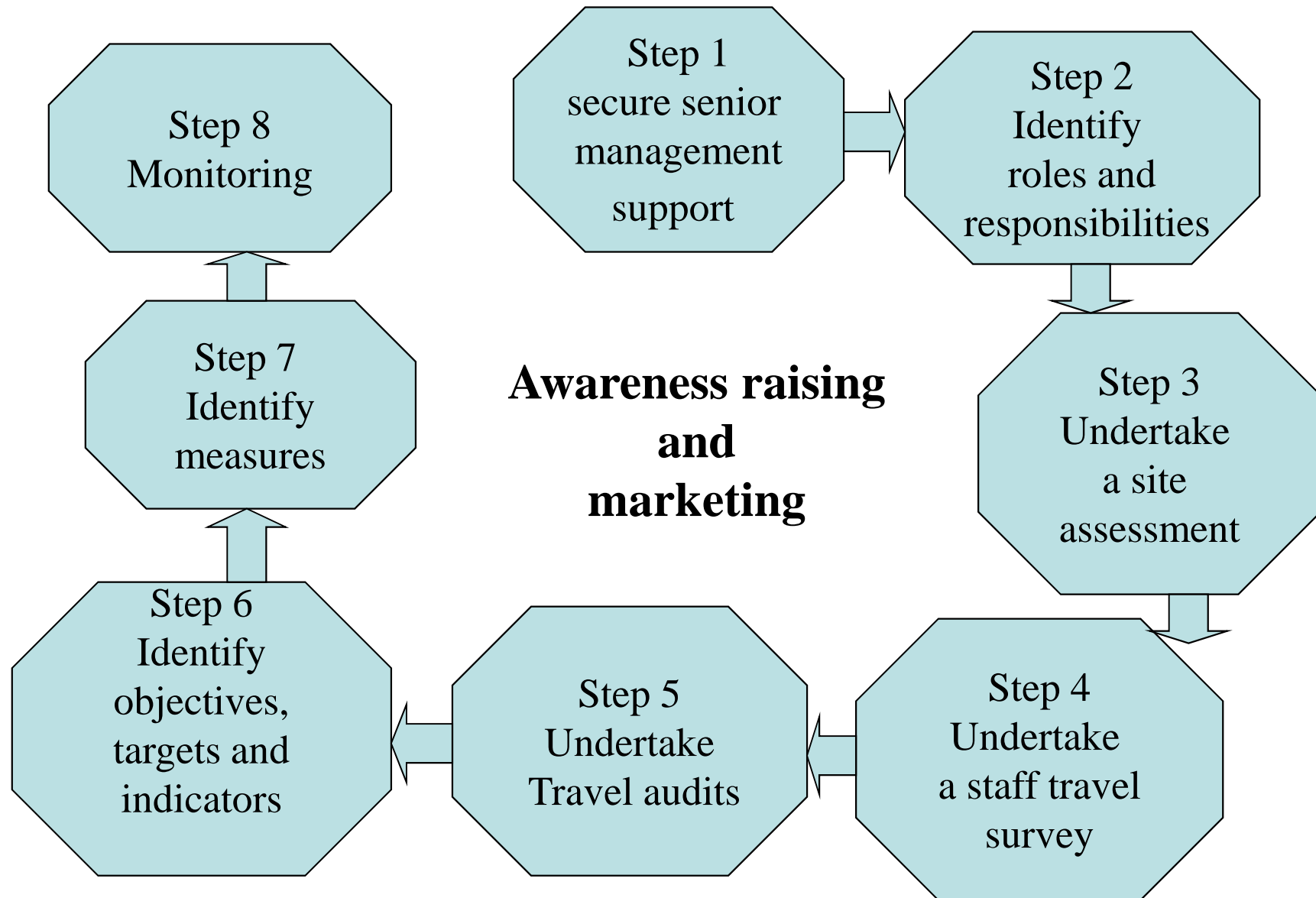

Aims of the training

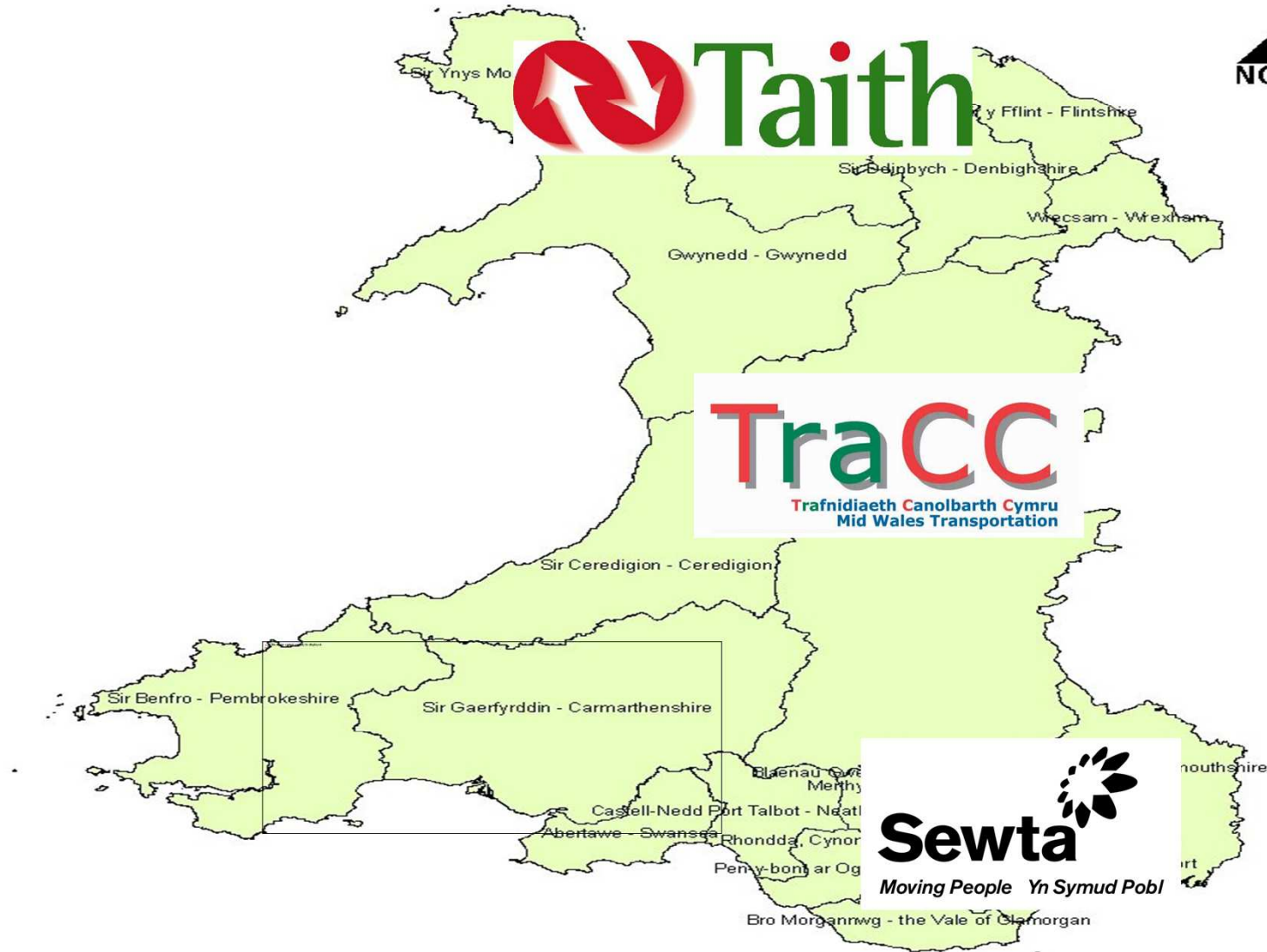

- Discounted tickets
- Monthly
- Weekly
- All day riders
- Employer subsidised tickets

Concessionary Bus Travel

- All over 60s have free travel in Wales
- All those in receipt of disability allowance at the higher rate
- All those with a revocation letter from DVLA where a medical condition has meant loss of driving licence

Young Persons Railcard

- For off peak travel 10am or later Monday to Friday
- Costs £26 (£18 if disabled)
- Save 1/3 off travel throughout Great Britain for a whole year
